

In 2022

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife
Service provided \$5.4 Million
for 78 on-the-ground
conservation projects across
37 States. Partners provided a
9-to-1 funding match with an
additional \$47.6 Million
supporting the 78 projects.

Since 2006

The National Fish
Habitat Partnership
implemented 1,299
conservation projects in
all 50 States.

From 2017-2022

Conservation project funding of \$23.7 Million from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service has been leveraged by \$167.8 Million in matching partnership funds.
