The National Fish Habitat Partnership (NFHP) works to conserve fish habitat nationwide by leveraging federal, state, tribal, and private funding resources to achieve the greatest effect on fish populations through priority conservation projects facilitated by NFHP's 20 Fish Habitat Partnerships. In 2020, the NFHP program was codified through the America's Conservation Enhancement Act (PL 116-188), and was reauthorized in 2024.

### **\$23.4 Million for Fish Habitat Conservation in 2025**

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service provided \$5.9 Million for 91 on-the-ground conservation projects. Partners provided a 3.6-to-1 funding match with an additional \$21.5 million supporting projects.



### **Since 2006**

The National Fish Habitat Partnership has implemented over 1,500 conservation projects spanning all 50 states, generating over \$380 million in leveraged funding.

### **On-The-Ground**

Our conservation projects have reconnected more than 9,800 miles of rivers and streams while conserving over 70,000 acres of river, lake, riparian, upland, estuary and wetland habitat.



### **Progress Through Partnerships**

Our conservation projects have involved over 1,700 partner organizations, including federal and state agencies, conservation organizations and tribes.
