Fish-friendly road culvert

- SEAK FHP received grant from NFWF
- FHP needs to raise \$40K in privately raised funds

This effort has been deeply embraced in Alaska across the Tongass National Forest. Over the past 25 years, 500 miles of stream previously meeting fish passage standards were improved.

In spite of this good work, it is estimated that a third of remaining assessed road-stream crossings in the Tongass do not currently meet fish passage standards. To address this need, the U.S. Forest Service, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, and Southeast Alaska Fish Habitat Partnership have teamed up to develop the TONGASS TOP 5. The goal: design fish passage sites to a 'shovel ready' state and ultimately develop a plan to restore these remaining high priority sites for improved fish passage.
