# INTERAGENCY COORDINATION PROPOSAL

- Federal Interagency Fish Passage Task Force is made up of 13 federal agencies
- Is focused on longitudinal aquatic connectivity (i.e., BIL fish–passage)
- Intends to expand its scope to more holistic connectivity goals across diverse fish habitats including streams, lakes, floodplains, and estuaries



# INTERAGENCY COORDINATION PROPOSAL

- Federal Interagency Fish Passage Task Force is currently filling the role of a “federal caucus”
- To incorporate NFHP, the Task Force Coordinator will–
  - Provide biannual updates to the Board
  - Provide copies of the annual Work Plan and Accomplishments Report to the Board
  - Provide responses to Board inquiries regarding federal interagency coordination in support of fish habitat
  - Request assistance from FHPs on Task Force matters that are regional and multijurisdictional in nature
