ACE Act Re - Authorization Activity

- Bill introduced into the House
 - Overall, language remains the same as the House
 - Only exception, no increase in funding authorization levels
- House ACE Act Reauthorization Fact Sheet Available
- Next steps

Ace Act 2.0 (House Version)

- Adding two Board Seats (BLM, and ensuring EFMC and MFC have a seat)
 ACE Act funding timeline remove "following fiscal year" language to provide flexible funding timeline driven by the Board
 Federal match requirement changes
 50% of the total cost of all fish habitat conservation projects come from non-Federal funds (Partnership level match)
 - Board authority to recommend operations funding have no cost-share
- Add BLM to agencies receiving technical assistance and get funding for it
- Increase authorization funding to \$10 million (from \$7.2)
- Add an authorization of \$1M for the National Fish Habitat Assessment

Ace Act 2.0 (House Version)

- Reauthorization of the NFHP program through 2030
- Clarification on annual report on updates to FHPs: required only when there are changes
- Clarification on 5-year summary report: have one condensed report as opposed to two overlapping reports
- Exemption to be added that would allow FHP coordination "projects" to be submitted without non-Federal match requirement

Scientific & Technical Support

- Thank you to federal agencies who provided summaries of their NFHP scientific and technical support
- NFHP Policy committee recognizes an opportunity to request scientific and technical support appropriations for FY 26
 - Proposal: collaborate with federal agencies* to submit a formal request to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) and advocate for inclusion in the President's budget
- Request from the Board: a sense of whether or not policy committee proceed with this approach
 - Suggested next steps for engaging with federal agencies

Other Policy Committee Activities

Congressional designation: sent letters to staff members of the committees listed in the ACE Act requesting feedback on designation submission

The committee is working on a governance document that outlines the terms of reference for the committee
