In 2020, the NFHP program was codified through the America's Conservation Enhancement Act (PL 116-188).


\$27.4 MILLION FOR FISH CONSERVATION IN 2024

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service provided \$5.9 Million for 91 on-the-ground conservation projects. Partners provided a 3.6-to-1 funding match with an additional \$21.5 million supporting projects.

SINCE 2006

Since 2006, the National Fish Habitat Partnership has implemented over 1,500 conservation projects in all 50 states, generating over \$380 million in leveraged funding.





ON-THE-GROUND

Our conservation projects have reconnected more than 9,800 miles of rivers and streams while conserving over 70,000 acres of river, lake, riparian, upland, estuary and wetland habitat.

PROGRESS THROUGH PARTNERSHIPS

Our conservation projects have involved over 1,700 partner organizations, including federal and state agencies, NGO's and tribes.
