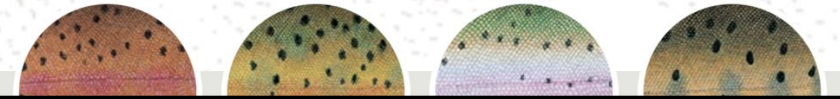
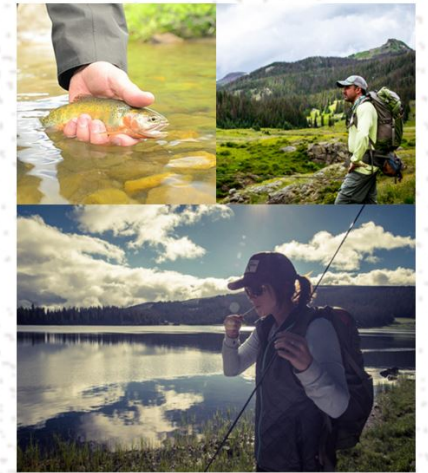



There is a rare species of desert fish fighting for its survival in a fresh water pond in the desert landscape of southern Nevada -- the Pahrump poolfish.

One of the last remaining populations of the endangered Pahrump poolfish, *Epiplatys latos*, is at an alarmingly low number, below 1,000, compared to the 10,000 recorded in 2000.

In the fall, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service moved 100 poolfish from Lake Harriett at Nevada, and moved them to Lake Mead National

The poolfish are being reintroduced to the lake. According to Harter, "The poolfish exists."

The inter-agency team is working on native plant and animal habitat before reintroducing
